

Improving ICT Infrastructure for Health Care in Uganda



The 1991 agreement through the Interstate Commerce Commission (ICC) that kept railroads open and active during the last year of the century, according to a report by Joseph W. Hooton, Jr., president of the American Association of Public Transportation, "was the only thing that kept the railroads from being completely dismantled." The 1991 agreement of the ICC to allow the railroads to operate their own lines and to sell their assets to private companies was a significant step in the development of the railroads.

It differs from 1970's in a somewhat fundamental principle: it is not one single media function that dominates, still the use of printing and mass media is declining. 1970's was based on the mass production and distribution of mass media, creating media culture and differences.

The main goal of the intervention is to increase the number of women working within the health sector, thereby ensuring that the health sector is not dependent on men. This is done by providing women with the necessary skills and knowledge to work in the health sector.
